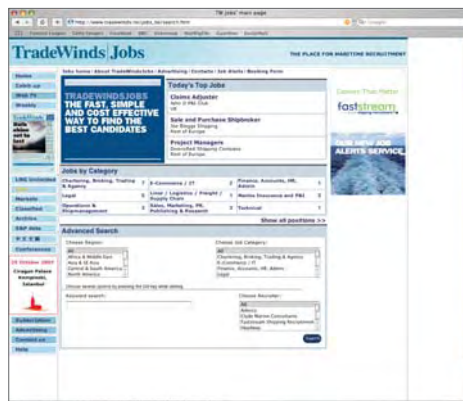

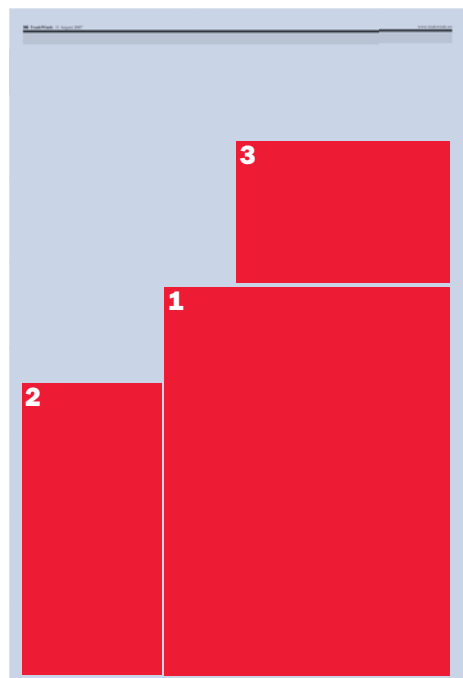

Acceptable formats: PDF, EPS, PostScript, QuarkXPress, Photoshop & Illustrator files. Files must be high resolution (180 dpi or more), CMYK/Greyscale and fonts embedded or outlined.

Text appears jagged if produced as a greyscale or CMYK picture. Bitmap or vector graphics produce a sharp edge.
